KNOW BEFORE YOU BUY

RV Lots	Lots 4 & 5
Lots Open	8 a.m., Thursday, November 19, 2026
Pass Type	Three-day RV parking passes only
Checkout	All RVs out by noon, Sunday, November 22, 2026
Your Space	20 ft. x 40 ft. — RV and everything you set up must fit inside
Towing Anything?	A separate permit is required for every towed item
Tow Credentials	Scan in and out every time; no tow movement after 8 a.m. ET
Hookups	None — plan to be fully self-contained
RV Re-Entry	Once your RV leaves the lot, it cannot return

Don't Get Turned Away at the Gate

Have your RV permit in hand — digital or printed — when you reach the attendant.

Towing ANYTHING (BBQ cooker or smoker, trailer, automobile) requires a separate permit for the towed item. Without it, you will not be admitted.

Arriving early won't get you in early. There is no staging area on stadium property.

PERMITS, TOW VEHICLES & YOUR SPACE

- Every RV in Lots 4 and 5 needs a 2026 Florida Classic RV permit, scanned at the entrance shown on your permit and the event map. Your permit determines which nights are authorized.
- Tow and companion vehicles need their own permit and a tow credential — scan in to enter, scan out to leave. Park where directed, never in drive aisles.
- Your RV and your entire tailgate — tents, tables, chairs, grills, generators, coolers, cords — must stay inside your 20 x 40 footprint.
- Park where staff assign you. Don't encroach on neighbors, save spaces, or move barricades, cones, or signs.

- **Fire lanes, drive aisles, sidewalks, walkways, and emergency access must stay clear at all times.**
- RV lots are for recreational vehicles only. Party buses, box trucks, and cargo trailers may be denied entry.

TENTS, GRILLS & GENERATORS

- Tents and canopies 10 x 10 or smaller are welcome if they fit your footprint and stay secured. Larger or commercial tents may require advance approval and a City of Orlando permit.
- In high wind or severe weather, staff may require tents, canopies, and flags to be lowered or removed.
- **Never leave a lit grill or smoker unattended.** No fires directly on pavement, grass, or ground. Position equipment so smoke doesn't affect neighbors.
- Hot coals and ashes may not go in regular trash cans or dumpsters — extinguish fully and use the designated container.
- Generators stay inside your footprint, exhaust pointed away from neighbors, at a reasonable noise level. Cords may not cross drive aisles, fire lanes, or walkways.

TRASH, GREASE & WASTEWATER

- Bag all trash and take it to a designated dumpster or collection area — not left in your space or behind after you go.
- **Cooking grease and fryer oil go only to a designated grease-disposal area.** Never onto pavement, grass, landscaping, a regular trash can, or a storm drain.
- **Never dump black water, gray water, or holding-tank waste on stadium property or into a storm drain.** Keep it contained and dispose of it off site.
- **You are responsible for leaving your space clean.** Improper dumping can mean removal, loss of privileges, and cleanup charges.

GUESTS & CONDUCT

As the permit holder, you are responsible for your space and everyone in your party.

- Keep music and amplified sound reasonable, per stadium and City of Orlando requirements.
- Alcohol must comply with Florida law and stadium policy. No unauthorized vending, solicitation, or advertising.
- Supervise children — the lots have moving vehicles, cooking equipment, and generators. Pets must follow the event's pet and service-animal rules and may not be left unattended.
- Personal golf carts, scooters, and similar vehicles are not permitted inside the event perimeter.
- **Drones and remote-controlled aircraft are prohibited** anywhere on stadium property, including the RV and tailgating lots, without prior written approval from stadium management. Violators may face removal and civil or criminal penalties.

DRIVING, WEATHER & CHECKOUT

- Drive slowly and yield to pedestrians and staff. Vehicle movement may be restricted during heavy pedestrian activity, arrival, or postgame departure.

- During lightning, severe weather, or flooding, lot entrances and movement may be temporarily held. Follow all public-safety directions.
- **All RVs must be out by noon, Sunday, November 22, 2026.** Remove all property, equipment, trash, and grease first, and depart by designated routes when directed.

TAILGATING IN OTHER LOTS & ENFORCEMENT

Tailgating is permitted in Camping World Stadium lots except bus lots and Jones High School lots. The rules above apply wherever tailgating is allowed.

Follow this guide, posted signage, your permit conditions, and the directions of event, parking, security, fire, police, and stadium personnel. Life safety comes first — staff may require any equipment to be moved, secured, shut down, or removed. Failure to comply may result in removal from the lot, towing at the owner's expense, loss of parking privileges, cleanup or damage charges, and referral to law enforcement.
